

## **POST-SURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

<u>SUPERVISION</u> Please allows 30 minutes to 1-hour recovery time before leaving our office. A child must be in a car seat and wear a seat belt. After the procedure, you will be drowsy, with poor balance and coordination for about 6-8 hours. Children need to be supervised for the rest of the day. Avoid stairs, running, climbing, or playing outdoors. Schooling is generally permitted the next day. In some instances, a child may react in a combative manner similar to a temper tantrum. Adults are not to drive automobiles or operate machinery for the rest of the day until recovery is completed.

**EATING/DRINKING** Minor side effects such as drowsiness, dry throat, shivering, headaches, and dizziness are common. Nausea may be present but vomiting is less common.

Avoid all food and liquids for **2 hour after leaving the office**. Take clear liquids such as juice, water or clear soda for 2 additional hours. Diet may be slowly advanced to soft foods such as milk, cereal, soup, Jello, pudding, yogurt, bread etc as tolerated. Pain and low-grade fever should be treated with Tylenol® or Ibuprofen®. Please notify Dr. Tran or your dentist if the temperature is higher than 100.5 F, or vomiting continues for more than 8 hours.
